Logline:

In the 1920's USA, an ambitious bank employee arrives at the haunted seaside town of Innsmouth. Unable to let go when his business mission fails, he decides to spend the night there, only to find that when the sun sets and the tide is high the whole town turns savage and tries to kill him.

Synopsis:

Loosely based on the Lovecraft story 'Innsmouth' the 11 minute animated short film takes us to the 1920's, USA. Bobby, the ambitious employee of a large bank, arrives in the haunted town of Innsmouth, with the mission to convince the reclusive millionaire to sell some of his property to his company. He soon realises that something is really off in the village. People look strange the buildings are about to collapse and there is a rancid smell lingering everywhere. When his business offer is rejected his boss encourages to stay for the night and try again the following day. Although he has a bad feeling about this, he agrees to stay. When the sun sets the high tide floods the village, and the locals gather and try to catch Bobby who manages to run away from them. He tries to find safety and the millionaire's estate, but soon realises it is all a trap. He manages to escape again but with the road to safety in eyesight he gets stuck in mud and gets caught eventually. When his hat is added to a collection at the estate the audience finds out that Bobby's life was actually part of the business deal between the bank and the millionaire.
